

# Case Study: Creating an Outdoor Classroom

There is direct access from indoor classrooms to outdoor space.

Direct access from classrooms to this outside corner space make it an ideal spot for an outdoor classroom.

Students can research design for a structure that reflects local history and culture. The 'classroom' should be big enough to accommodate benches or seats for a class-size group.

Native trees and shrubs are planted together to mimic and recreate local habitat and attract butterflies and birds to the area.

Pathways to and from the outdoor and indoor classrooms and connecting to the main walkway wind through the landscape for observation and access for maintenance and watering.

A smaller sala with benches and seating in shaded areas under trees makes this a retreat place too.
